Registration and Collection

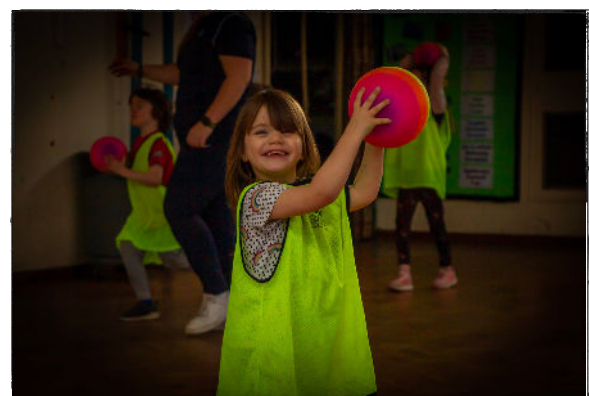
Our team will already have your contact details on our system, but you will be asked to reconfirm these.

Upon collection, if the main doors are closed, the coaches will display contact numbers to call to collect. Doors will be open 8.30 - 9.45am and 4.15pm - 5.30pm only.



What to bring?

- A refillable drinks bottle
- A packed lunch - please ensure they are nut free, and avoid foods that require refrigeration
- Healthy snacks for break times
- We do not allow phones or tablets at our camps



What to wear?

Children will need to wear loose, comfortable clothing (such as tracksuit trousers, shorts, leggings) and safe footwear for both indoor and outdoor activities (trainers strongly recommended). Sun cream can be sent in on sunny days, but children are required to apply it.
